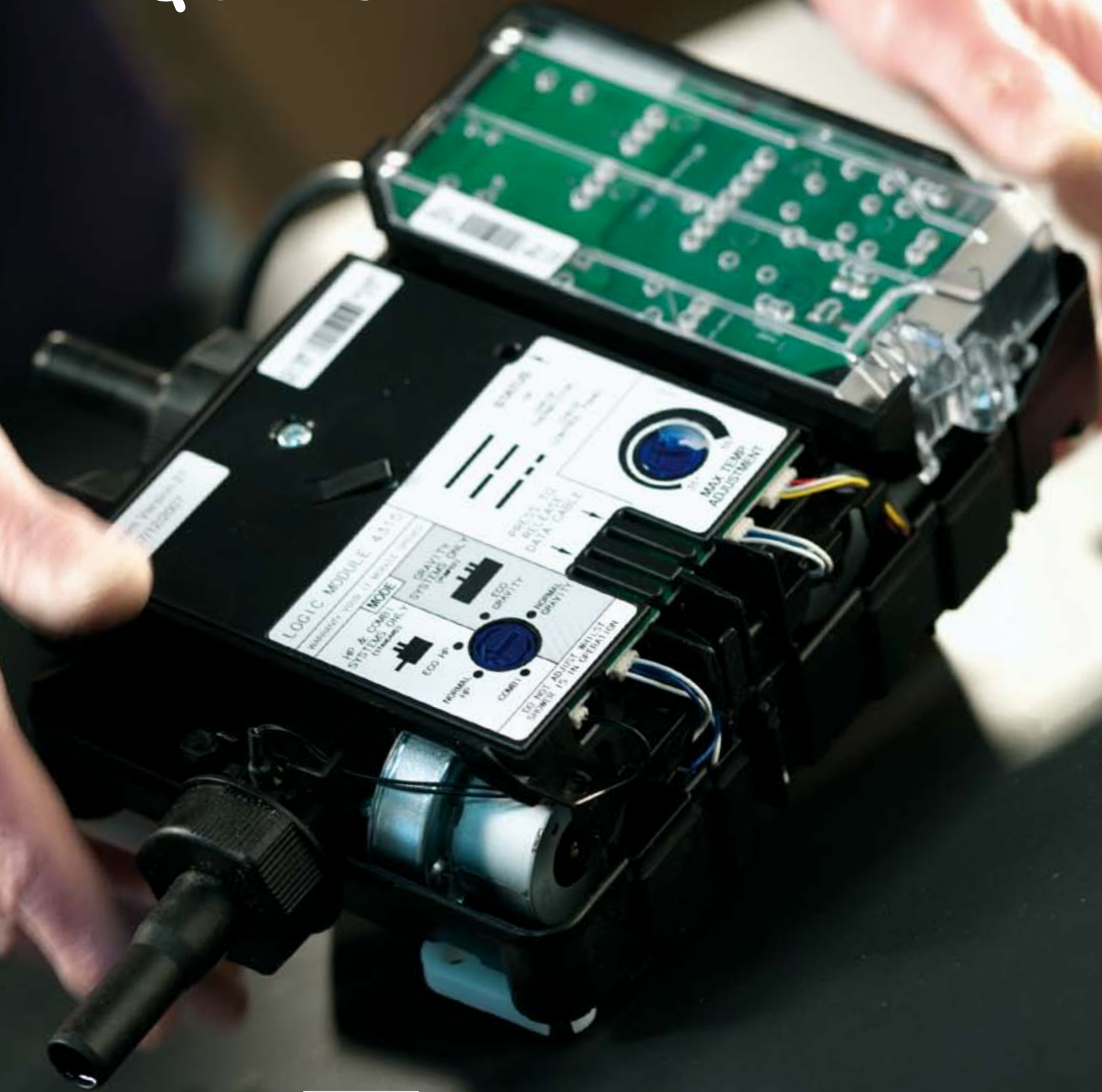

What will I learn at a seminar?

The seminars are hands-on and have both technical and theoretical content. Who should attend?

Where are the courses held?

Our training team covers the whole of the UK including the Channel Islands and Ireland. We hold seminars at local venues throughout the country, in addition to our purpose-built training centre at our Head Office in Kent.

What's a typical seminar like?

Seminars are held for up to 12 delegates and begin at either 9am or 10am with coffee and tea to kick-start everyone. We provide lunch and there are morning and afternoon coffee breaks, with the day ending at either 3pm or 4pm. We create a relaxed, hands-on learning environment and delegates are encouraged to ask questions. Attendees receive comprehensive notes and technical literature is available. 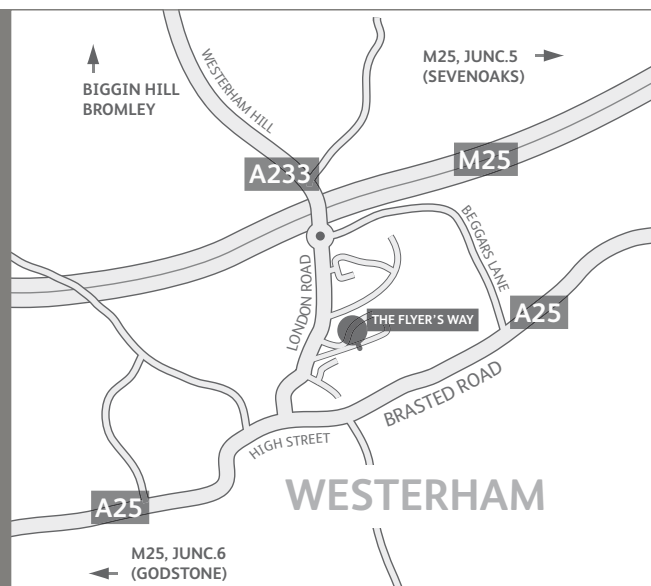
By train:

We are a 15 minute taxi ride from Oxted (Southern Trains) and Sevenoaks (South Eastern Trains).

By car:

Junction 6 on the M25 follow signs to the A25 in the direction of Oxted and Westerham. When you arrive in Westerham turn left onto the A23 signposted Biggin Hill (London Road), just after the George & Dragon public house. The Flyer's Way is the 3rd turning on the right.

From Junction 5 on the M25 take the A25 through Sundridge and Brasted. Turn right at the turning for Biggin Hill (Beggars Lane). At the roundabout take the first exit, heading for Westerham. The Flyer's Way is the 3rd turning on the left.
